## CYPRUS, NICOSIA SECOND LTTA

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## LTTA PROGRAM


**Day 1 - PR1:** The first day was under the responsibility of the organizers who, after welcoming the participants in Nicosia, made a small introduction to the project and its significance for the future of volunteering in Europe. Then there was a presentation on the results of PR1, which led to a creative dialogue between the participants. The day ended with a fun game.

**Day 2 - PR2:** On the second day, Pista Magica from Portugal took over, where, in addition to the importance of inclusive volunteering, they presented the results of PR2. The presentation once again led to an interesting discussion which, like the previous day, ended with a particularly interesting activity/game.

**Day 3 - PR3:** The coordinator of the project, Anna Purola, starts the day with a review of the path of the project, from the level of its writing until today. He then reported and presented the results of PR3. In the second part of the day, the Sosped team turned Stando into an excellent simulation of Finland's Cultural houses, achieving the enthusiasm of all participants

**Day 4 - VolGo!** activities: On the fourth day, the participants had the opportunity to have fun and at the same time learn through the excellent activities of the trainers from the Mreza Mama organization. The day was spent in various activities and games in empowering young people and information about volunteering in Slovenia. At the end of the day, the trainers had the opportunity to meet and review the past week.

**Day 5 - Venture the old Nicosia:** on the last day of the training, the organizers organized a morning walk in the old walled city of Nicosia. The city tour led to the Severis museum where the trainees had the opportunity to learn more about the intangible cultural heritage of the island.
